BAC - Bickard Awards Committee

Bid-A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as Proposal and Tender. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5(c))

Bidder - Refers to a contractor; manufacture; supplier; distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

Bidding Downerts – The downerts issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information recessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])
