

These Hilipine Bidding Documents (PBDs) for the procuement of Goods through Competitive Bidding have been prepared by the Government of the Hilippines for use by any banch, constitutional commission or office, agency, department, buseu, office, or instrumentality of the Government of the Hilippines, National Government Agencies, including Government Owned and/or Controlled Corporations, Government Agencies, institutions, State Universities and Colleges, and Local Government Unit. The procedures and practices presented in this document have been developed through bood experience, and are for mandatory use imposeds that are firm read in while or impart by the Government of the Hilippines or any foreign government/foreign or international firm ring institution in accordance with the provisions of the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No 9184

The Biding Documents shall dealy and adequately define, among oftens (i) the objectives, scope, and expected outputs and/or results of the proposed contract or Francework Agreement, as the case may be; (ii) the eligibility requirements of Biddes; (iii) the expected contractor Francework Agreement duration, the estimated quantity in the case of procuement of goods, delivery schedule and/or time frame, and (iv) the obligations, duties, and/or functions of the winning bidder:

The Special Conditions of Contract (SCO) complement the GCC, specifying contractual requirements linked to the special circumstances of the Procuring Entity, the Procuring Entity's country, the sector, and the Goods purchased In preparing this Section, the following aspects should be dedeed

- a Information that complements provisions of the GCC must be incorporated
- b Anerchents and or supplements to provisions of the GOC as recessitated by the circumstances of the specific puckets, must also be incorporated
